



MAIN DIFFERENCES

Between

The Youth World Championships (YWC)

and

The Youth Olympic Games (YOG)

1. FREQUENCY

- YWC:

Organized every year except in the year of YOG

- YOG:

Organized every 4 years

2. AGE GROUP

- YWC: athletes aged between 13 and 17 years
(for 2009 YWC athletes born between 1 January 1992 and 31 December 1996)
- YOG: athletes aged between 16 and 17 years
(for 2010 YOG athletes born between 1 January 1993 and 31 December 1994)

3. PARTICIPATION

■ YWC:

- open
- maximum 8 men and 7 women per NF
- maximum 2 athletes per category per NF

■ YOG:

- 60 men and 50 women through Qualification System
- maximum 2 men and 2 women per NOC
- maximum 1 athlete per category per NOC
