



## Women's 63kg - Review

### Deng Wei gives China first gold in women's 63kg in four years

- Deng Wei (CHN) became the first Chinese woman to win gold in the Total in the women's 63kg since Liu Haixia (CHN) won all three gold medals in 2007.
- The last Chinese woman with a gold medal in the women's 63kg was Ouyang Xiaofang (CHN), who won the Snatch in 2010.
- Deng also won the Snatch in the women's 58kg in last year's World Championships, becoming the first person to win a gold medal in two different weight categories in 2013 and 2014 World Championships combined.
- China have now won 14 gold medals in this event, more than double the number of world titles than the next best country (Russia, 6).
- Romela Begaj (ALB) won the Snatch and became the first ever gold medallist for Albania in a women's event at the World Championships.
- She became the second person from Albania to become world champion in any sport that is currently on the Olympic curriculum, after Daniel Godelli (ALB) won gold in the men's 77kg (Snatch and Total) on Wednesday.
