



Review Men's 55kg

- Om Yun Chol (PRK) added three world titles to his victories in the Clean & Jerk and Total in the men's 56kg at the 2013, 2014 and 2015 world championships, for a total of nine in the competition.
- He surpassed Kim Un Guk (PRK) for most world titles among lifters representing DPR Korea. Kim won seven from 2010 to 2014 (men's 62kg events).
- Josue Brachi Garcia (ESP) won bronze in the Snatch, his second world championships medal, after he also claimed bronze in the 56kg Snatch last year.
- He became the first Spanish man with two world championships medals.
- Teerapat Chomchuen (THA) claimed bronze at age 17 years and 94 days in the Clean & Jerk and became the youngest Thai to win a weightlifting medal at the world championships.
- He became the youngest man with a medal in the competition since Szymon Koleccki (POL) took bronze in the men's 94kg Clean & Jerk in 1998 (17 years, 34 days).
