



Review Men's 73kg

- Shi Zhiyong (CHN) won all three world titles in the men's 73kg.
- Shi is the 11th Chinese man to win at least five world titles in weightlifting. He previously won two world titles in the 69kg in 2015, in the Total and Clean & Jerk.
- Shi is the first Chinese man to win three world titles in one weight category since Chen Lijun in the 62kg in 2015.
- Won Jeongsik (KOR) finished second in the Clean & Jerk and Total while performing in Group B.
- Won has now claimed six world championships podiums, equalling Lee Bae-Young (KOR, 6) in second place all-time among men from Republic of Korea. Only Chun Byung-Kwan (KOR, 9) has claimed more.
- Vadzim Likharev (BLR) finished second in the Snatch and third in the Total. He is the second Belarusian man to finish on the podium in a weight category under 76kg, after Gennady Oleshchuk won two world titles and claimed a third place in the 62kg in 2001.
- Nijat Rahimov (KAZ), third in the Clean & Jerk, collected his fourth world championships podium. In 2015, he won the 77kg Total and Clean & Jerk, while finishing third in the Snatch.
