



Review Men's 81kg

- Mohamed Ihab Youssef Ahmed Mahmoud (EGY) won three medals, including gold in the Snatch. He has now won 11 total medals, including four world titles.
- Mahmoud already had the most medals among Egyptian weightlifters and now also surpassed Nahla Ramadan (EGY) and Khadr Sayed El Thouni (EGY) on a record four world titles among Egyptians.
- Lyu Xiaojun (CHN) claimed silver in the Snatch and Clean & Jerk and won the Total.
- He has now finished on the podium 16 times at the world championships, including 10 world titles. He set the Chinese record of most medals, previously held by Li Hongyun (CHN, 15) and He Yingqiang (CHN, 15).
- Lyu was 34 years and 101 days old today and became the oldest Chinese weightlifter winning a world championships medal since Chen Manlin (CHN) in 1942.
- Li Dayin (CHN) also claimed three medals, including gold in the Clean & Jerk.
- China has now won nine world titles in Ashgabat, equalling Thailand for most at these world championships.
- China's 33 medals in all events combined, are 20 more than the next best country as Thailand has 13.
