



Review Women's 55kg

- Sukanya Srisurat won the world title in the Snatch, Clean & Jerk and the Total in the women's 55kg.
- With her three new world titles Srisurat became the first weightlifter from Thailand to win medals at four different world championships.
- Thai women have now claimed all nine women's events at the world championships in Ashgabat.
- Thailand's nine world titles in women's events is already the best achievement for Thai female lifters at a world championships, beating their five world titles from 2017.
- Li Yajun (CHN) added two more silver medals (Snatch and Total) to her three world titles in the women's 53kg category in 2013 and three bronzes in the same weight class in 2014.
- Cristina Iovu (ROU) claimed bronze in the Clean & Jerk. She became the third female medallist from Romania at the world championships after Loredana Elena Toma (3 world titles in 2017) and Roxana Cocos (bronze in 2011).
